Please let us know if you need anything and one of us will be glad to help you! ☺

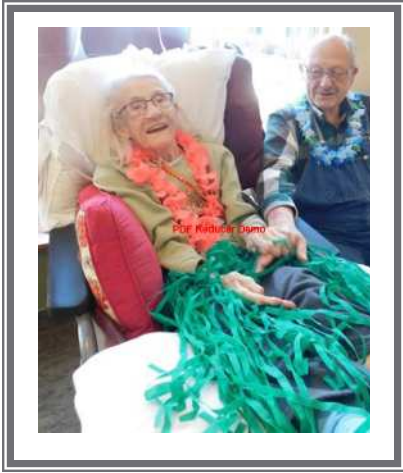
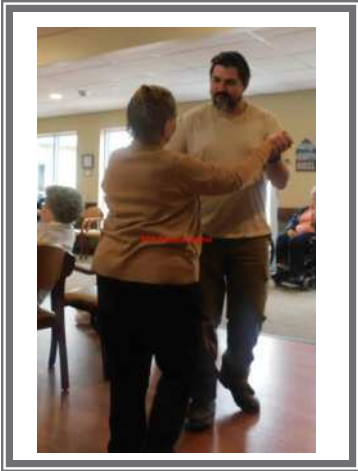
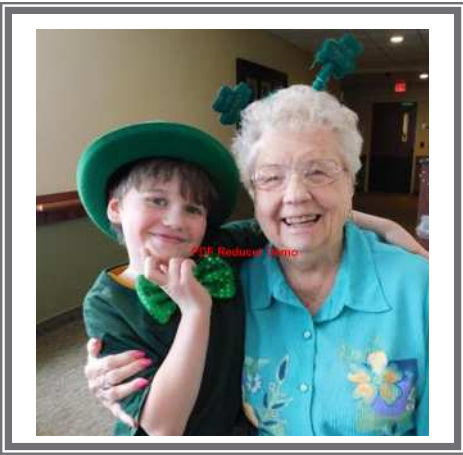
LIFE ENRICHMENT
